Thank you very much for approaching the PD-Forum with regards to plans to further develop the Gold Standard through a comprehensive program with the BMU.


With reference to the e-mail and Concept Note sent by Michael Schlup on the 17th of March 2010, I would like to offer the general support of the PD-Forum.
